Catford & Bromley Synagogue is an orthodox synagogue, affiliated to the United Synagogue organisation, which comes under the overall guidance of the Chief Rabbi.

The Synagogue has been established since 1937 and moved to the Crantock Road site in 1952.

The membership consists of around 230 families.

The core membership is grouped around Bromley, Beckenham, North Kent, and South-East London postal codes.

There is a mixed age range with approximately 70% seniors, 20% middle aged, and 10% young adults.

There is a small but vibrant cheder and nursery with children up to, and beyond, bar mitzvah and bat chayil age.

There is an active Maccabi Youth Club with its own self-contained hall, club rooms, and youth leader.
